### Statutory Listed Buildings

- Grade I. These are buildings of exceptional interest  
Grade II\*. These are particularly important buildings  
Grade II. These are buildings of special interest, which warrant every effort being made to preserve them

In Herne & Broomfield all the Statutory Listed Buildings are Grade 2, except for St Martin's Church and Herne Windmill which are both Grade I.
