14/16	<p>Update on the progress of the Community Centre build and fund raising efforts, 100 club. The clerk distributed the updated plans received from the architect and reported that a drainage survey had been requested and progress was being made with regard to construction materials. Slates, bricks, air source heat pumps and PV panels were discussed. There was some discussion on the updated drawings, details of the toilets and new parish office as well as discussion on the amount of sustainable technologies that would be practical.</p> <p>The clerk reported that the profit from the 100 club for the year was £351, the Garden Safari had raised £2,408 and the Race Night £399.30 Mabel presented a cheque for £710 for the Nosh & Knowledge, Cllr Davis thanked her and Ann Berry for all their hard work organising the event. Cllr Davis asked if there was going to be another Bingo night, the clerk will liaise with Robert & Tracey Jones on this. The clerk reminded everyone that the next Race Night was on 7th May. The parish council will have a tombola at the Strode Park 70th Anniversary event, the proceeds will go to the Community Centre. Prizes for the tombola are being requested.</p>

	<p>Request from Alan King to purchase 3 more tables at £71. The clerk told members that the hall manager was concerned as to how the existing hall would be managed during construction of the new hall, especially as it had been mentioned previously that the lobby area and part of the kitchen might need to be demolished early on in the build. Cllr Blatherwick thought it was better to wait until after the tender stage and then discuss this further.
